FINDINGS:

Engine built in 1907
Boiler in very poor condition, fittings also bad.
Throttle valve leaking badly
Broken and patched engine frame
Broken and patched cylinder
Running gear and spring rigging very poor
Only engine on system equipped with Stevenson
valve gear therefore parts for it not on hand

RECOMMENDATIONS:*

For the above reasons I would recommend
Engine 23 be disposed of with exception of air pumps
bell and other parts that can be used on other
engines.
